



GLOBAL LABOUR MARKET OUTLOOK- 2025

GERMANY

- **Most Sought Occupations:** Nurses, Commercial Sales Representatives, Software Developers, Systems Analysts, and Accountants.
- **Key Sectors:** The highest demand is in Manufacturing, Human Health and Social Work, Wholesale and Retail Trade, Information and Communication Technology (ICT), and Construction.
- **Skill Level:** Germany has a strong need for both highly skilled and middle-skilled professionals, with a preference for mid-level technical expertise.

CANADA

- **Most Sought Occupations:** Food Service Counter Attendants, Cooks, Restaurant Managers, and Truck Drivers. There is also demand for Sales Managers, Child Care Workers, and Carpenters.
- **Key Sectors:** Vacancies are concentrated in Accommodation and Food Services, Wholesale and Retail Trade, Construction, and Manufacturing.
- **Skill Level:** Canada is an attractive destination for both skilled and semi-skilled workers, as job opportunities are distributed across all skill levels.



UNITED ARAB EMIRATES (UAE)

- **Most Sought Occupations:** Accountants, Sales and Marketing Managers, Software Developers, and Civil Engineers.
- **Key Sectors:** The highest number of jobs are in Professional and Technical Services, Real Estate, ICT, and Administrative Services.
- **Skill Level:** The UAE's labor market is dominated by highly skilled job vacancies, which account for over 84% of postings. There is very limited demand for low-skilled work.

QATAR

- **Most Sought Occupations:** Software Developers, Administrative Managers, Civil Engineers, and Financial Analysts.
- **Key Sectors:** The demand is primarily in Administrative Support, ICT, Financial Services, and Professional Services.
- **Skill Level:** Qatar's market is focused on highly skilled roles, with Professionals, Managers, and Associate Professionals making up the majority of vacancies. As with the UAE, demand for low-skilled jobs is extremely limited.
